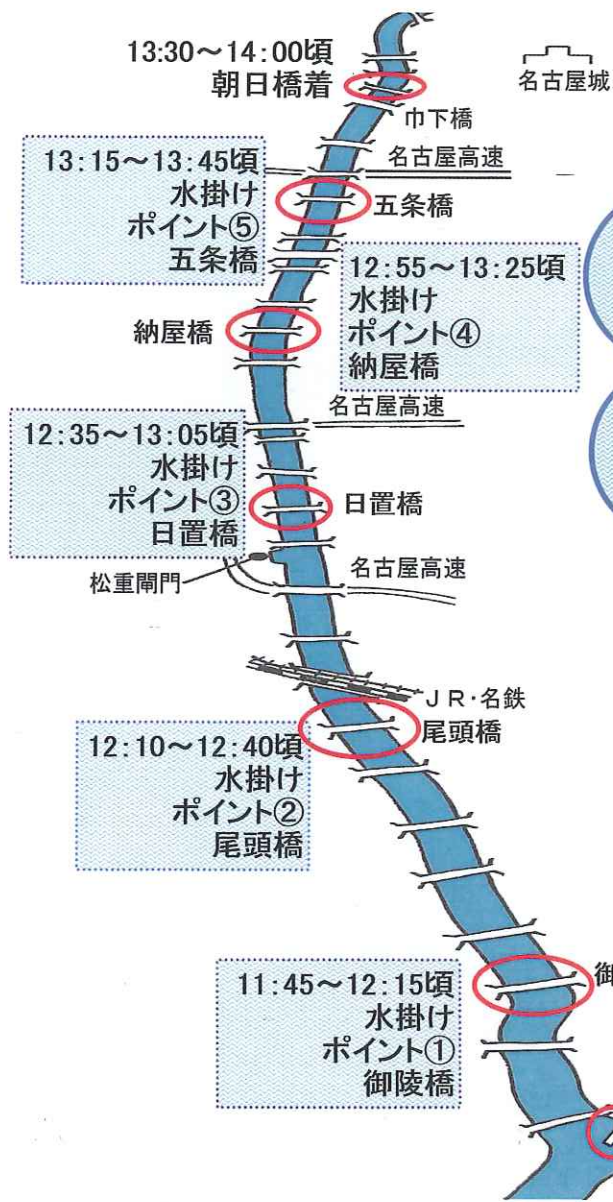

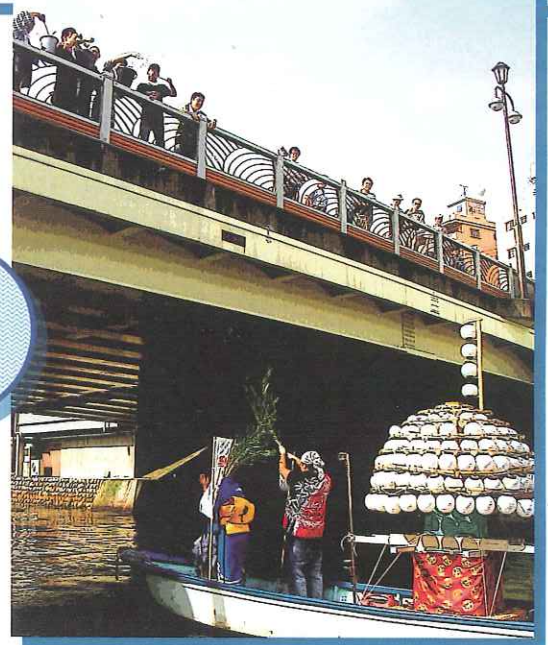

## “THE NAGOYA CASTLE & THE HORIKAWA MAKIWARA FESTIVAL” August 6 (Fri.) & 7 (Sat.), 2010 THE HORIKAWA 400th ANNIVERSARY

Especially this year, you will enjoy “The Nagoya Castle & The Horikawa Makiwara Festival” which celebrates 400th anniversary of the Nagoya castle fortification.  
It will be held on the evening of August 6 (Fri.) & 7 (Sat.) around the Nagoya castle park and the Horikawa areas.  
Highlights are Japanese-drum roll, Makiwara Dasi and Makiwara Boats which are decorated with 365 + 12 lanterns on the water moat, wishing Horikawa River to become clear stream.

- 6 (Fri.) 17:00~20:30 at north side of the Nagoya castle  
Large and middle Makiwara boats float on the water moat.
- 7 (Sat.) 12:00~14:00 at Miyanowatashi (Miya Ferry) ~ Asahibashi  
Small Makiwara boat move up the Horikawa to bless the river.

Large, middle and small Makiwara Boats float on the water moat.
